

Refraction Services and Fees

Refraction is an essential part of an eye exam. It is necessary to perform a refraction to determine whether eye diseases or refraction errors are responsible for your current visual acuity. A refraction is performed at a new patient visit, an annual visit, a cataract consultation, or anytime there has been a change or decrease in your vision. However, a refraction is a separate fee that is not covered by Medicare and most insurance plans.

Eye Physicians & Surgeons' fee for this refraction service is \$65.00 and is due at the time before the service is rendered. You have the right to decline a refraction service.
